- 2. One or two sentence introduction/overview
- 3. Motivation
- 4. Background
- 5. Detailed Method (of studies you report on, or of your survey)
- 6. Examples of Application, Use, or Results
- 7. Concluding Summary (stressing practical applications)
- 8. References for further investigation
- 9. References to sources cited in the body of the essay

Style

- □ avoid colloquialisms
- $\hfill\square$ avoid contractions
- □ pages should be numbered
- □ don't allow dangling referents
- $\hfill\square$ omit needless words

- □ conclude with a summary
- $\hfill\square$ report should be self-contained
- □ treat citations as parenthetical
- you must provide page numbers when quoting printed material
- □ provide evidence (or at least citation) for claims
